

Residential Function Guide



Passage – Hallways/Latching Closets

No cylinder and is freely operational from both sides of the door at all times.



Privacy – Bedrooms/Bathroom

No cylinder, but can be locked from the inside only via pushbutton or thumbturn. Privacy locks have an emergency release mechanism on the outside.



Dummy – Non-Latching Doors

Non-turning or latching function, commonly used as a pull for bi-fold closet doors or pantries where a "catch" may be used to hold the door closed. As a handleset, used on the non-locking side of a double-door entrance.



Keyed Entry – Entrance

Keyed cylinder facing the outside and a thumbturn on the interior. When the door is locked, it can only be opened with a key from the outside.



Storeroom – Restricted Areas

Used to prevent open access, Storeroom functions can only be opened with a key and cannot be left unlocked. From the inside, the lock can always be opened.
